

STOR 151, Spring 2024, Midterm 1, February 8

This is an *open book, in class* exam, that will take place during the normal class period. If for any reason you are unable to attend, please talk with the instructor as soon as possible.

You are allowed to bring your text (*OpenIntro Statistics*, Fourth Edition), personal notes, homework assignments (if you like) and a calculator. You are allowed to ask the instructor any questions of clarification during the exam, but beyond that, no communication with other individuals either inside or outside the exam room is allowed. You may use your cellphone calculator on the strict understanding that the cellphone is not to be used for texts or other forms of messaging during the exam. You may also use a computer or tablet if you require this to view an electronic copy of the course text or notes, but again, not to communicate with anyone other than the instructor. Breaking these rules may be treated as a violation of the Honor Code.

The material covered will be the course text up to Section 3.2, but omitting the sections that we never covered in class (2.1.6, 2.1.7, 2.1.8, 2.3).

My intention is to print out the exam in advance with enough spaces for you to enter your answers. These may include drawing scatterplots, histograms and other forms of data plotting by hand. You will not be expected (or allowed) to use computer software such as Excel during the exam. You will not need a “blue book”.
